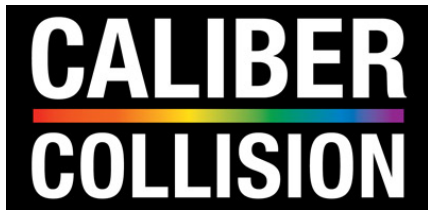
## **Caliber Collision Opens New Collision Repair Center In Las Vegas Region**
